## AUSTRALASIAN INTER-SERVICE INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (AIIMS)

### Course overview

#### 22202VIC Course in the Australasian Inter-service Incident Management System

There are no pre requisites for this course. You will however need the literacy and skills to:

- Interpret a range of written text
- Identify and work within an action plan
- Communicate effectively and work within timelines
- Analyse critical information effectively within the incident action plans.

### Certification

This is an accredited training course. Upon successful completion of the course participants will receive a nationally recognised Statement of Attainment in the following competency:

#### This course includes:

- Purpose of AIIMS
- Features and benefits of applying AIIMS
- AIIMS principles and concepts
- Scope of incident control, planning, logistics, operations, intelligence and finance functions.

### Target audience

This course is appropriate for personnel who will perform an intermediary role in an incident management structure. This course provides entry level training for personnel prior to specialising in specific AIIMS roles of Planning, Operations, Logistics and Incident Control.

### Duration

- 16 Hours (2 x 8 hour days)  
or
- Online + One day practical scenario/workshop

### Attendance

#### Face to face

A two day face to face accredited AIIMS Course designed to provide participants with an understanding of the principles and processes that underpin the Australasian Inter-service Incident Management System (AIIMS) and its adoption and use in emergency incident management.

There are a maximum number of 15 participants per course. *Course numbers can be adjusted according to location.*

Day 2	Practical Scenario/Exercise assessment

#### Online

A 16 hour online, interactive, accredited AIIMS Course designed to provide participants with an understanding of the principles and processes that underpin the Australasian Inter-service Incident Management System (AIIMS) and its adoption and use in emergency incident management.

On the successful completion of the online content there is a scenario based workshop, this has a maximum number of 10 participants, which is required to be completed 90 days after the completion of the online modules.
